"COMPETITION FOR DESIGN OF FORMATION ON GYANPATH"

As a part of Independence Day Ceremony, 2025 (IDC-2025), a "Competition for Design of Formation on Gyanpath" will be conducted by Ministry of Defence in coordination with MyGov.in during 01st - 15th May, 2025 in order to create patriotic feelings among youth and masses. Participants are to design/draw Gyanpath Design (Formation to be made by NCC Cadets/NSS Volunteers/School Children along with the backdrop thereon) at Red Fort, Delhi on the Independence Day Ceremony, 2025. Gyanpath designs of the last 3 years' Independence Day Celebrations are attached for ready reference.

Salient features:

- (i) There are three cash prizes for top three entries of Rs. 10,000/- each.
- (ii) Top 250 participants along with one companion (spouse/guardian/relative etc.) would be issued e-initiation for witnessing the Independence Day Ceremony, 2025
- (iii) Participants to the Competition will be issued online generated Certificate of Participation by MyGov.

Terms & Conditions

- (a) Participants to the competition must be a Citizen of India.
- (b) An individual can participate only one time.
- (c) Top 03 participants will be awarded the cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- each.
- (d) Top 250 participants would be issued e-invitation for witnessing Independence Day Celebrations-2025 at Red Fort, Delhi along with one companion (guardian/
- (e) The top 250 participants, selected for issuing invitation for Independence Day Celebrations-2025 at Red fort will be requested to provide following mandatory details in respect of self and one companion (guardian/ spouse/relative etc.)


- (g) One mobile number & one email ID cannot be used by more than one participant for one competition/quiz during IDC-2025.
- (h) On receipt of e-mail or call from Ministry of Defence three winners will be required to submit requisite documents for disbursement of winning prize/payment viz. ID proof & Bank Details, copy of canceled cheque etc.
- (i) It may be noted that Ministry of Defence will issued e-invitation for the event and all the expenses related to travel, lodging, food etc. to attend the IDC-2025 will be borne by the individual himself/herself.
- (j) Entries should be in JPG/PDF/any other format whether hand designed or computerized as per the requirement of MyGov portal. If the reference of any image/logo has been taken in the preparation of Design for competition, participant is required to upload the referred image along with the final design.

(k) Use of any unfair/spurious means/ malpractices including but not limited to impersonation, double participation etc. during the participation in the competition, will result in rejection of participation.

- (I) No copy right image should be used and an undertaking regarding the same to be furnished. Non-furnishing of the same will render the selection null and void. Furthermore, the organizers of the competition or any agency acting on their behalf reserves all rights in this regard.
- (m) Employees, directly or indirectly connected with organizing the competition, are not eligible to participate in the competition. This ineligibility also applies to their immediate family members.
- (n) Winners will be announced on the basis of screening of the entries by a designated Screening Committee in Ministry of Defence. Decision of the Screening Committee may not be challenged further in any mode.
- (o) Designs furnished by any participant may be used by Ministry of Defence partially or fully for the purpose of design of Gyanpath at Red Fort. Any claim for the copyright of the designs submitted during the ibid competition will not be made by the participants at any span of time. Therefore, as per the requirement of Ministry of Defence, any of the participants may be asked to submit the details, concept note, editable design in raw format (preferably in native design tool format) including the embedded images used in the design.
